

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The following conditions of entry will apply to all Hindmarsh Stadium customers.

These conditions should be read in conjunction with the ticket conditions appearing on each ticket that apply to all ticket holders.

Refusal of Entry

For the comfort, safety and enjoyment of all patrons, Hindmarsh Stadium management reserves the right to:

- Refuse entry to any person deemed to be intoxicated and / or disorderly;
- Refuse entry to any unauthorised persons;
- Refuse entry of items, which have the potential to cause injury or public nuisance (i.e. large flags / banners, musical instruments etc).

General Conditions

- All patrons may be subject to personal / bag searches before entering the venue.
- Persons gaining unauthorised access to Hindmarsh Stadium and / or the venue's arena may be liable for prosecution.
- Patrons who cause a disturbance, or refuse to comply with requests made by Hindmarsh Stadium staff will be evicted.
- Security cameras operate at this stadium and patrons may be filmed / photographed.
- Alcoholic beverages cannot be taken into or from Hindmarsh Stadium.
- Smoking is not permitted within Hindmarsh Stadium but smoking is permitted in designated areas outside the gates.
- Patrons wishing to bring personal items into Hindmarsh Stadium do so at their own risk. Hindmarsh Stadium will not be held responsible for any damages to, loss or theft of a patron's personal property.
- Umbrellas may be brought into the Stadium but for the comfort of others cannot be raised whilst any activities are taking place on the arena.
- Patrons must refrain from using foul or abusive language and from making racial or threatening remarks or gestures.
- Some areas of Hindmarsh Stadium are exposed to direct sunlight and heat. Patrons are required to take appropriate care for their sun protection and hydration.
- Seats retract automatically, check your seat before you sit down.
- Some sporting and other activities are dangerous. Patrons viewing such activities do so at their own risk.

Restricted / Prohibited Items

- Glass, Bottles, Cans, Coolers, Iceboxes or Eskies
- Knives or other dangerous weapons
- Flares, Fireworks, Explosives or Smoke Bombs
- Laser pointers
- Alcohol or Illegal Substances
- Signs, Banners or Flags of non-participating teams / countries

- Flags and banners must **NOT** exceed 1 metre in length and 1 metre in width, without prior stadium approval
- Poles other than wood or plastic or in excess of 1.6 metres in length and **NO** more than 0.75 centimeters in diameter
- Animals – (except official guide or hearing dogs) – passes must be shown
- Frisbees, Kites, Bicycles, Scooters, Skateboards, skates (including in-line skates)
- Not to wear or otherwise display commercial, political or other offensive signage or logos
- Chopped or shredded paper which can be used as confetti
- Any item that the Stadium Management considers inappropriate
- **STADIUM MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CONFISCATE THE ABOVE ITEMS**

Liquor Licencing

“All persons entering Hindmarsh Stadium are advised that:

- They are entering licenced premises;
- Intoxicated persons will not be permitted to enter;
- Persons in possession of liquor will not be permitted to enter;
- Checking procedures will apply to prevent persons possessing liquor from entering;
- Intoxicated persons will be removed from the premises;
- It is an offence for minors to purchase and consume liquor;
- It is an offence to purchase liquor for (or supply liquor to) minors;

The Stadium Management can refuse entry or remove people of they,

- 1. Do not obey the above rules**
- 2. Are disruptive**
- 3. Interfere with the enjoyment, comfort or safety of others**
- 4. Refuse to allow any inspection of clothing, baggage, containers or person**
- 5. Have a lost, stolen, counterfeit, damaged or unreadable ticket**
